NOTICE AND PROCLAMATION OF

DATING VIOLENCE AWARENESS MONTH February 2010

IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF PALM BAY, BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

WHEREAS, dating violence is a reality for many young people, and an issue that many are unaware of, and

WHEREAS, 1 in 3 young people are affected by physical, sexual, or verbal dating violence with 1 in 5 in a serious relationship reporting having been slapped, pushed, hit, threatened or coerced by a partner, and breakups can be a time of even greater risk even when a relationship was never physically abusive, and

WHEREAS, young people can choose better relationships when they understand that healthy relationships are based on respect and learn to identify early warning signs of an abusive relationship, and

WHEREAS, elimination of dating violence must be achieved through cooperation of individuals, organizations, and communities, and

WHEREAS, Dating Violence Awareness Month provides an excellent opportunity for citizens to learn more about preventing dating violence and to show support for the numerous organizations and individuals who provide critical advocacy, services and assistance to victims.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, John J. Mazziotti, Mayor of the City of Palm Bay, by virtue of the authority of said office, do hereby proclaim February 2010 as:

DATING VIOLENCE AWARENESS MONTH

and urge the citizens of Palm Bay to actively participate and work toward the elimination of dating violence.
