- WHEREAS, Young people can choose better relationship when they understand that health relationships are based on respect and learn to identify early warning signs of an abusive relationship; and
- WHEREAS, Elimination of dating violence must be achieved through cooperation of individuals, organizations, and communities; and
- WHEREAS, Dating Violence Awareness & Prevention Month provides an excellent opportunity for citizens to learn more about preventing dating violence and to show support for the numerous organizations and individuals who provide critical advocacy, services and assistance to victims; and
